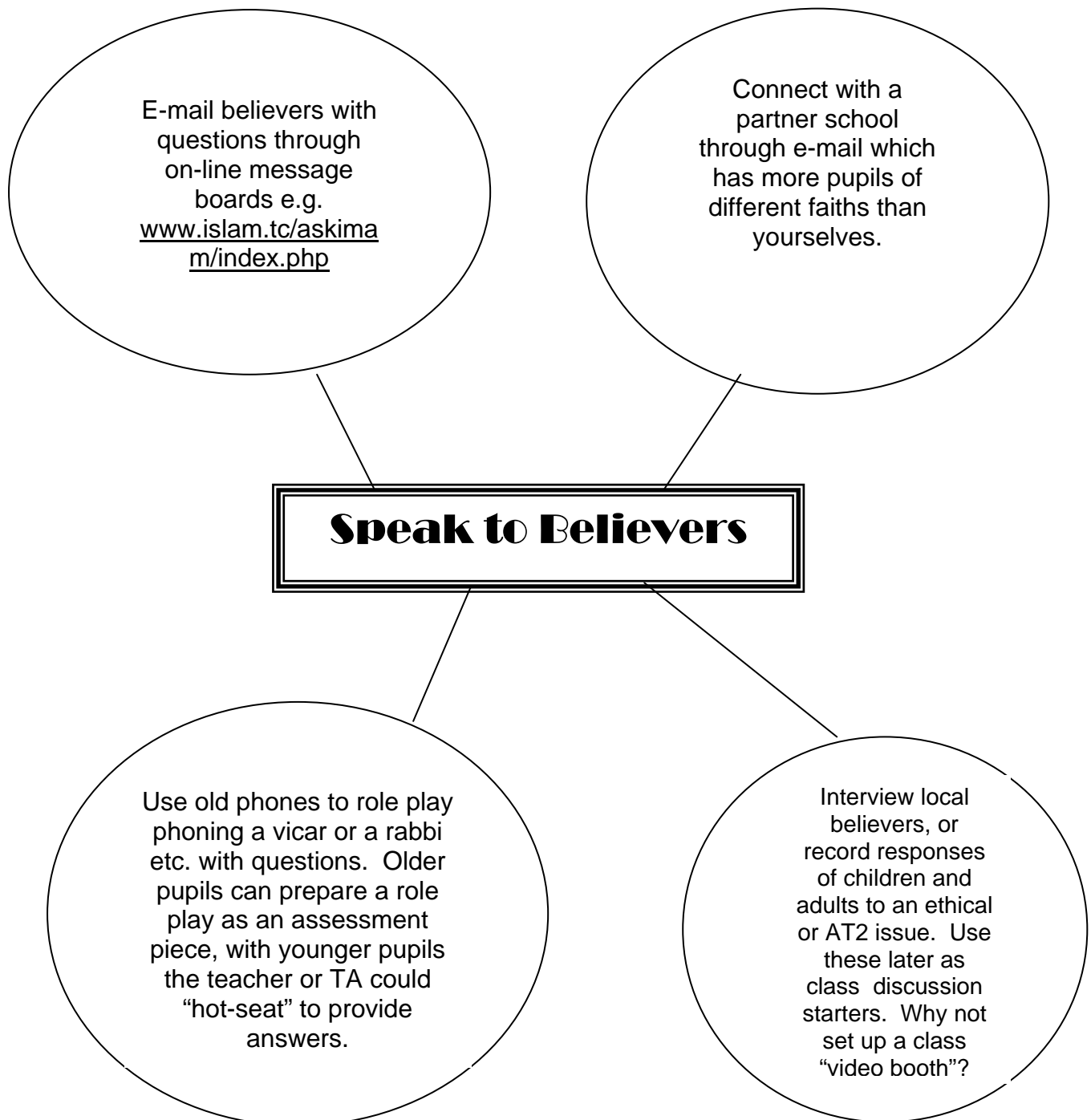
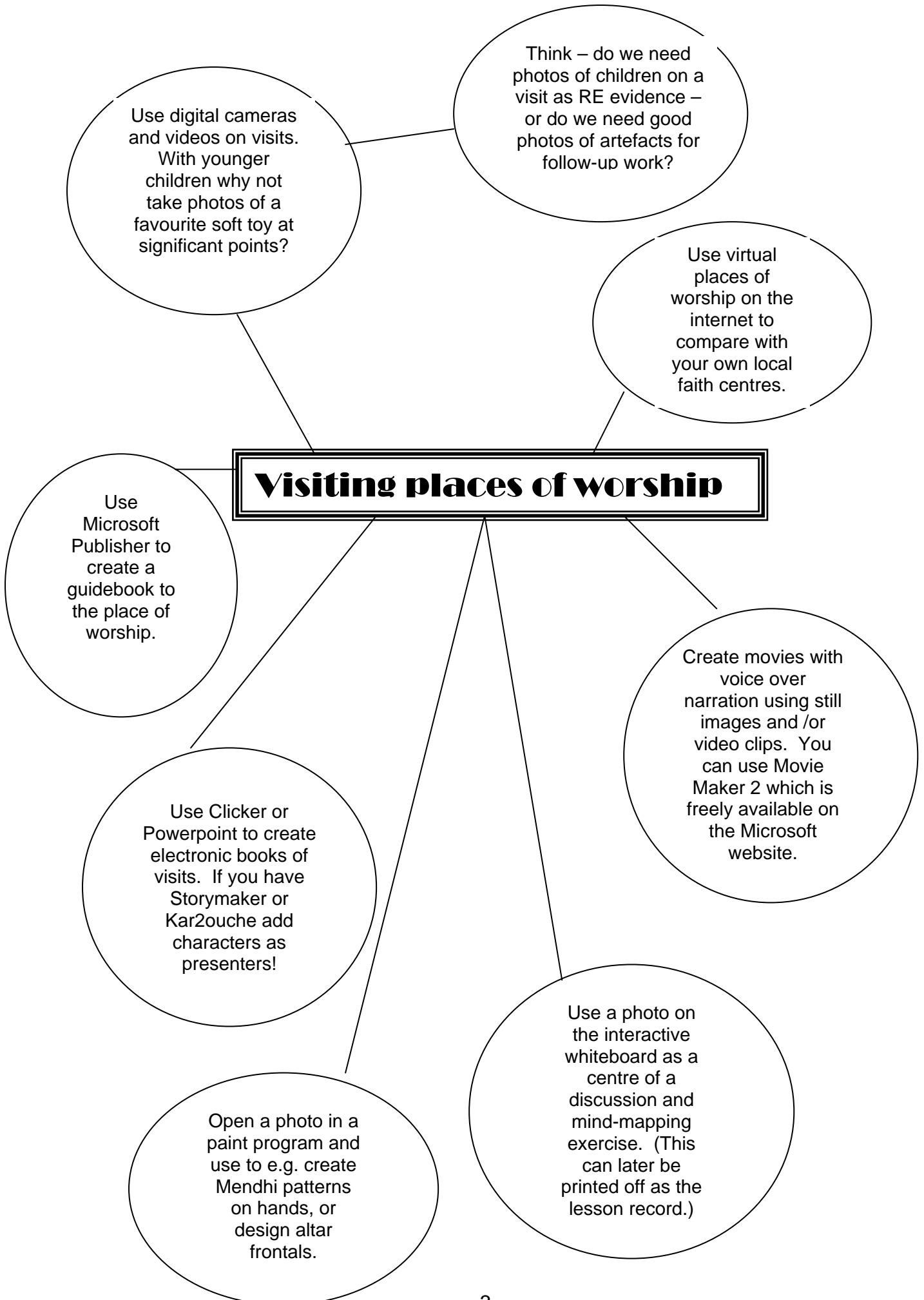
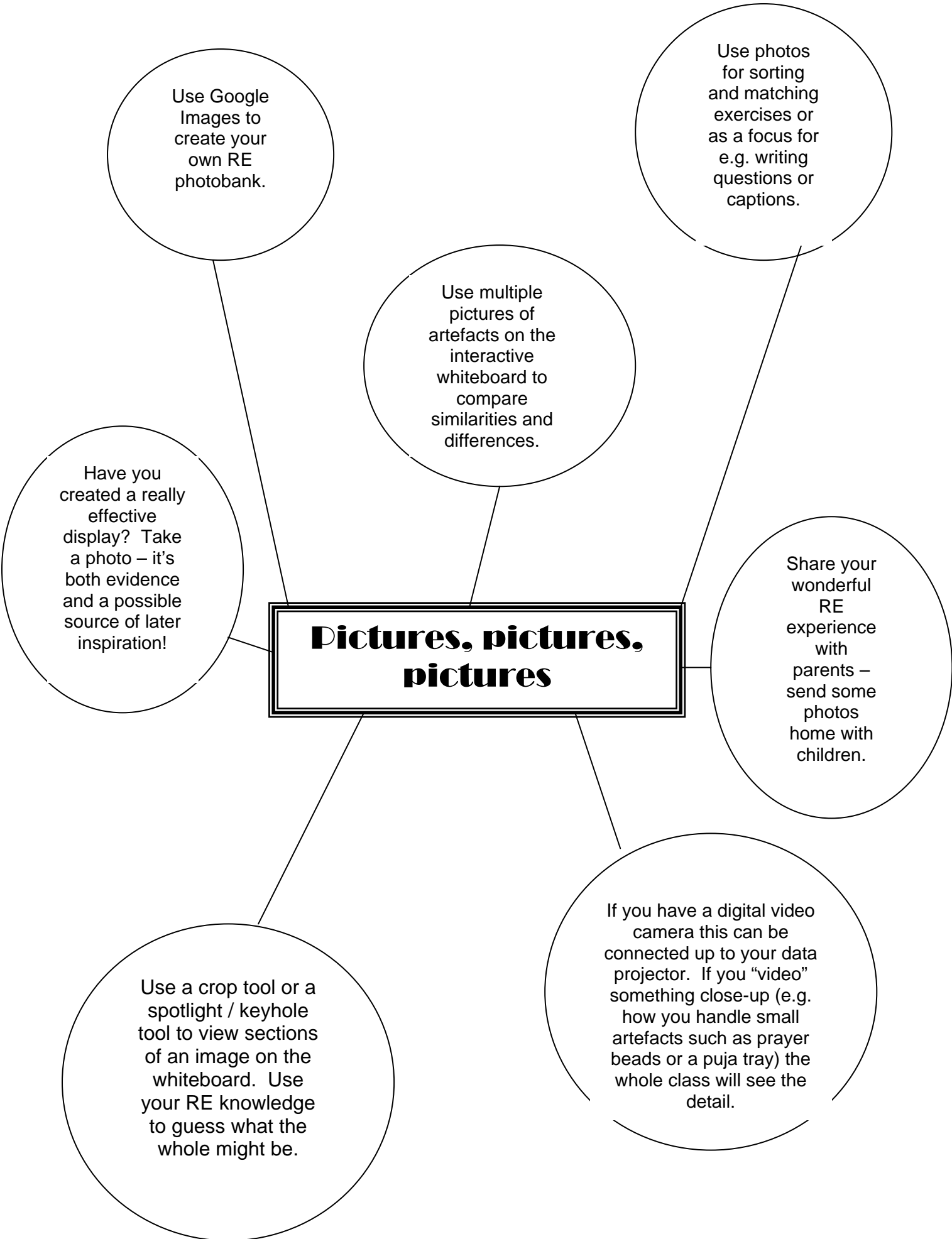


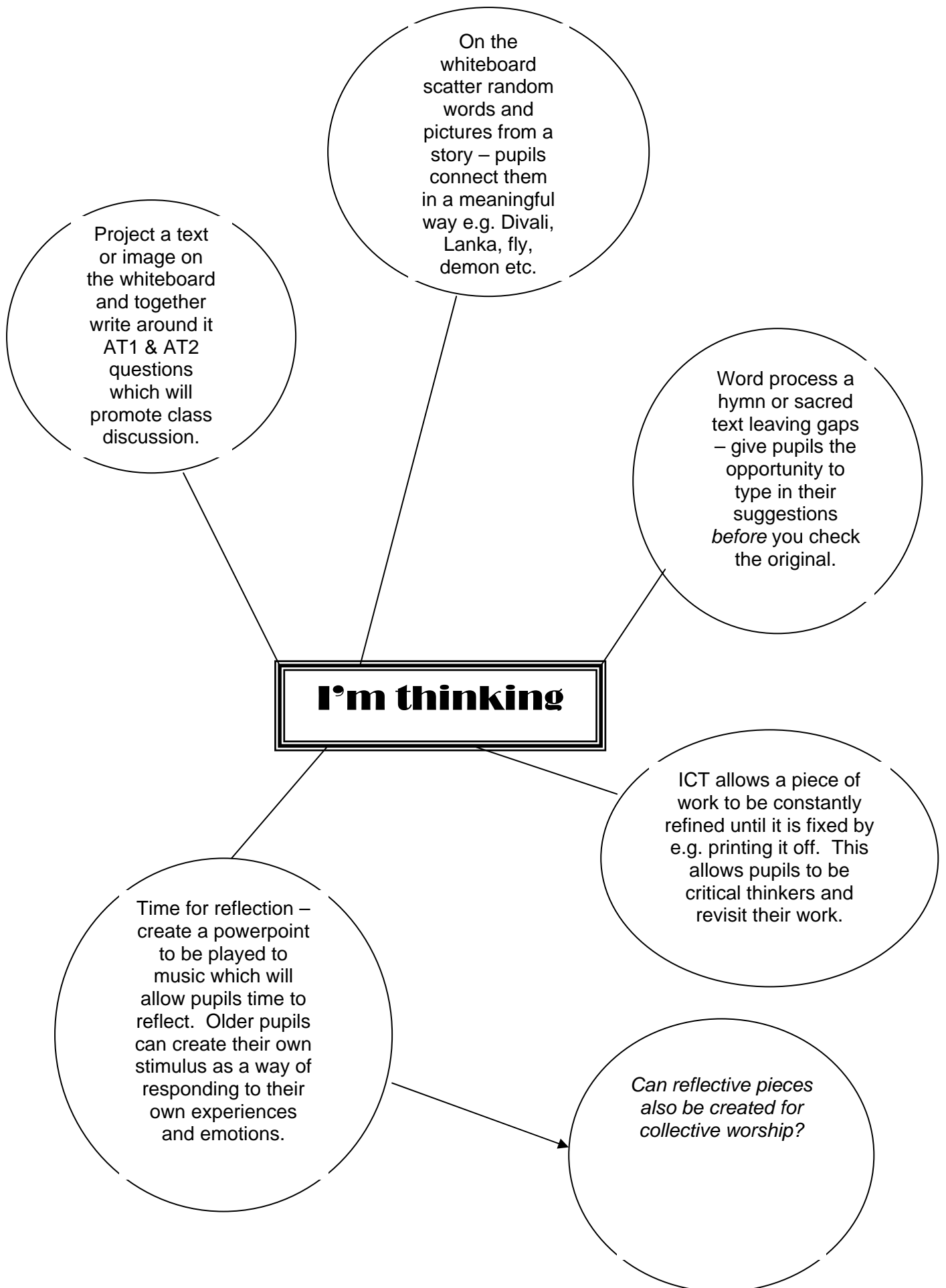
What can we do? RE with ICT Suggestions

Can't visit a mosque or find a Hindu visitor? The worldwide web helps RE classes to access at virtual first hand the experiences of real religious communities! It is also the case that a wider diversity of faith beliefs and practices can be found on the internet than in (often stereotypical) textbooks. Here are some RE cum ICT suggestions – some web based, others not....









Tell me a story

Use the internet or CD Roms to collect faith community stories –look for those ready to use with data projectors.

Record role play or drama with digital cameras or videos – use appropriate software to create your own digital story book.

Use a variety of story telling solutions to rework or update an RE story.

Show RE related film clips, without sound, to promote discussion.

Retell stories using Godly Play figures or play people and create a powerpoint with speech bubbles, or use to assess pupil recollection.

Shuffle pictures related to a story and ask younger pupils to reorder them.

Simpler story-telling: tell a story using hand-drawn OHTs, or use Storymaker or Kar2ouche to rewrite the story as a cartoon.

Use mindmapping software (e.g. Inspiration or 2Connect) to plot story characters and themes, then convert to written text.
