

Sequential Life of Jesus, with Gospel References

General Information

This presentation gives a probable chronological sequence of the events in Jesus' life by uniting the stories of the Four Gospels. Each event includes the appropriate Gospel reference(s). Most of the events occurred during the (approximate) three year Ministry of Jesus, and the following chart uses the annual Passover feast to help divide up the Ministry into historical segments.
