

Examples of Questions for the KS2 Church Audit Unit

- Exactly how is this object used in worship?
 - Does it have a special name? Is the name meant to tell us anything about it?
 - Is it in a special place in the building? Why there?
 - Is it used for a special service, or all the time?
 - What kind of worship is this used for? Do you have to do that to worship God properly?
 - How does it help worship?
 - Would it be more helpful if it were different in any way?
 - Does it have to be this shape/ colour/ size/ made of these materials?
 - Does it look like this because it has a special symbol on it or is used in a special symbolic way?
 - Could you use anything else to do the same job?
 - Does everybody in church need one/ use it?
 - Do all Christian churches have one?
 - What would happen if you didn't have one of these – would you still be able to worship God?
 - Do people think of it as holy and special, or is it just ordinary, or decoration? Is it important?
 - If you were told you could have a brand new modern one made, what would you like it to be made of/ look like? Would you want it to be the same or different?

- Do you have to come to this building to worship?
 - Is every service of worship held here exactly the same?
 - How do people expect the building to *feel*?

- Is the church building used for anything else other than worship? Would it be helpful for the village / community if it could have other uses?
 - If the church building is going to be a kind of community centre for the whole neighbourhood, then what else needs to be included?
