

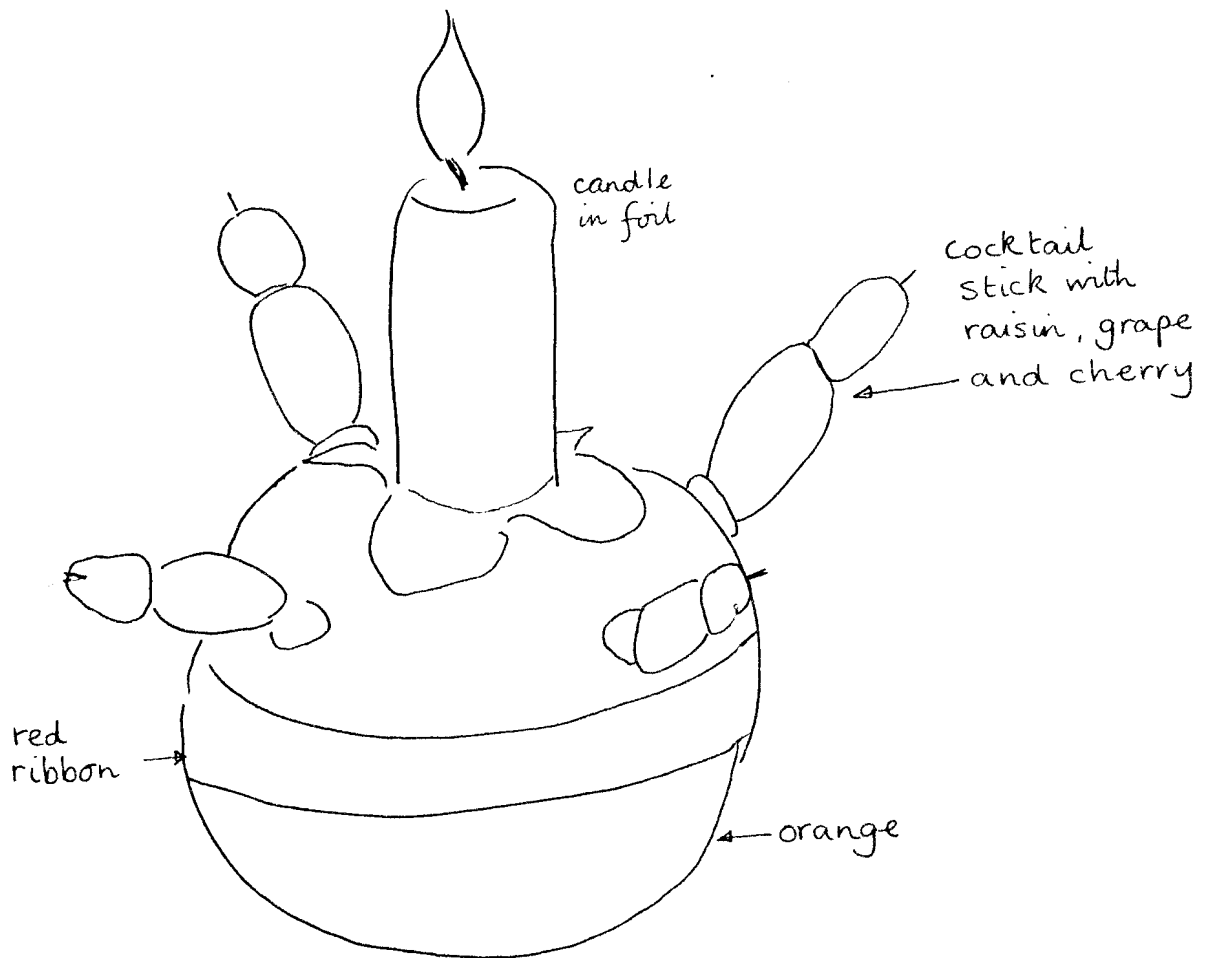
How to make a Christingle for Christmas, Year 1

The orange stands for the world.

The fruits are a reminder of the good things the world provides.

The red band is a reminder that Jesus died, and his blood shed to show God's love for the world.

The candle is a reminder that Jesus, with his message of love and forgiveness, is the light for the whole world.



To make a Christingle, cut a hole in an orange with an apple corer, wrap kitchen foil around the base of the candle and push it into the hole. Fan out the foil. Wrap red ribbon, or a strip of red paper, around the orange, and tape it into place. Thread fruits onto four cocktail sticks and stick these into the orange.
