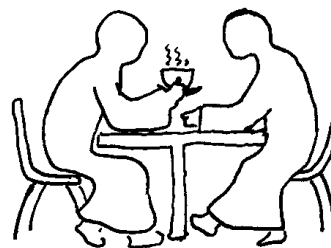
HOW DO YOU GET IN TOUCH?

A single visit may be all that is required, but it is possible for regular visits to be arranged for as long as it is helpful.
