# St Mary's The Parish Church of Buckden Newsletter, March 2012

Dear Friends

Most people don't like thinking or talking about death – when we have lost someone we love, or when we think we may do so in



the near future, it is simply too painful, and most of us don't like to think too much about our own funeral arrangements - maybe it feels 'morbid' or maybe we don't want to seem too demanding about our wishes, or maybe we just don't really want to think about it! But death is a reality. It's a reality that we all have to face not just for ourselves, but with and for those around us, too. And anyone who has planned a funeral will know that it's incredibly hard to make all the decisions you need to make about the service and other arrangements, just at a time when grief makes any kind of decision-making feel impossible. Talking with your loved ones about their (and your) wishes, and writing some of your ideas down, can be a hugely helpful thing. It has the obvious advantage that those planning the funeral have something to start from, and even when different members of the family have very different views, often they can unite. knowing that 'it was what they wanted'. But more importantly, talking about funeral arrangements is a really good way of preparing for death itself. Giving yourself (or a loved one) a chance to ask, 'How do I want to be remembered?' and 'What has been most important in my life that I want to celebrate?' and 'What prayers, hymns and readings express the faith that I have (however shaky that faith may feel in times of great need). It can be tremendously liberating and comforting to be able to think about these questions with the people you love and trust the most.

To that end, do come along on 21<sup>st</sup> March to the Friends in Deed 'Planning a Funeral' open meeting, at 7.30pm in the Lincoln Room (Buckden Millennium Centre). You will be a very welcome, and, I hope, encouraged. Your clergy are also happy to be approached if you would like some personal help thinking through these issues at any time.
