Those gathered in Jerusalem said, 'Aren't these all Galileans? How come we're hearing them talk in our various mother tongues? ...They're speaking our languages, describing God's mighty works?'

Over the last few months, you've heard lots of talk about 'mission' and 'mission action planning'. The Lent Groups encouraged us to think more about this... But what does all this mean...surely it's quite frightening.

At the end of the Easter season we celebrate Pentecost, often called the 'birthday of the church' At this time, we remember how the first disciples went and told all the people gathered in Jerusalem about Jesus.

21 centuries on, how do we 'speak the language' of those in our community, in order to 'describe God's mighty works?' We're still working hard on our key objectives for 2007/8, but now it's time to think about what next? There will be a variety of opportunities to contribute ideas.

For the people of Wilburton, looking at the key objective of the 21st development, there will be a special opportunity to think about what God is calling us to do next on **May 11th, Pentecost Sunday, during the 1000 service**. Please make every effort to be there- God wants us to listen to your voice!
