'There are fundamental differences between men and women but that is a creative thing, not a destructive one. Among the fundamental values linked to people's lives is what has been called a 'capacity for the other.' We each have within ourselves the deep intuition of goodness and of those actions which elicit life, and contribute to the growth and protection of the other.

In the final analysis, every human being, man or woman, is destined to be 'for the other', made by God for that purpose. So the proper promotion of equality within society must be understood and desired as a humanization accomplished through those values of goodness.

Every outlook which presents itself as a conflict between the genders is only an illusion and a danger; it would end in segregation and competition between men and women, whereas it is co-operation as equals that leads to freedom"
