The initial response for gifts and loans has been very generous, and there have also been a number of initiatives for raising money which are being or have been very successful.

The present situation is this:

The cost of repairs will be about £80,000
 In cash terms we either have or have the promise of
 about £60,000 in the Fund
 We have loans, or offers of loans, of £22,500
 Therefore the project can begin in December.

We aim to continue to work hard on the Appeal so that we can re-pay all the loans by the end of 2010.
